Presentations

Your presentations should be ready as soon as we meet in the seminar room.

Presentations should not be longer than 15 minutes to allow sufficient time for discussion.

If you would like to run a presentation, please take it on a USB stick with you. As a back up you can also send it to gerhard.fiolka@unifr.ch previously. Seminar rooms should be equipped with a projector with HDMI cable.

Seminar Papers

To validate the seminar as such in the sense of article 13a RRS/RED you will need to hand in a seminar paper on the topic of your presentation. It is possible to focus on specific aspects of the topic. If you feel that your paper should be narrower or wider than the presentation please contact G. Fiolka.

Papers should be 40000-50000 signs (including spaces and footnotes, excluding directories). This amounts to 13-17 pages.

Please hand in your papers in electronic format (word and pdf) via E-mail to gerhard.fiolka@unifr.ch. If faculty regulations require a hard copy at the time of handing in the paper please send it to Gerhard Fiolka, Departement Strafrecht, Beauregard 1700 Fribourg or leave it in the mail box at Beauregard 11. DO NOT send any registered mail and don't waste your money on A-Post+. For any deadline sending in the electronic version is sufficient.

We need any written work about one month before we need to hand in any grades. So if you want your grade for the 2nd session 2026, we should have your written work by end of may 2026, if you want it for the 1st session 2027 it should be there by the end of 2026. Please let us know if you need the grade for a specific graduation session. Please note that the ordinary correction deadlines of 3 months don't apply to seminars.

You will get a general grade for your presentation and your written work.
