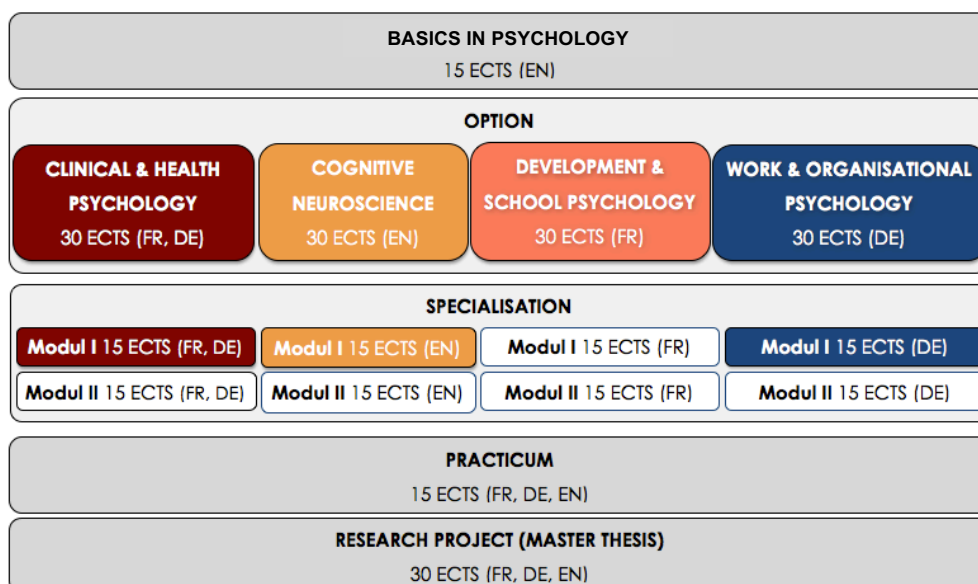

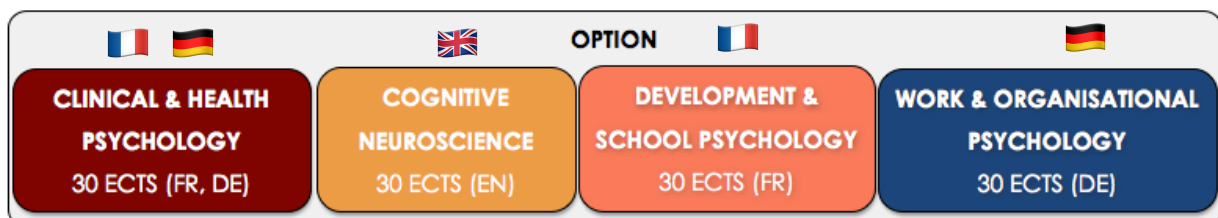

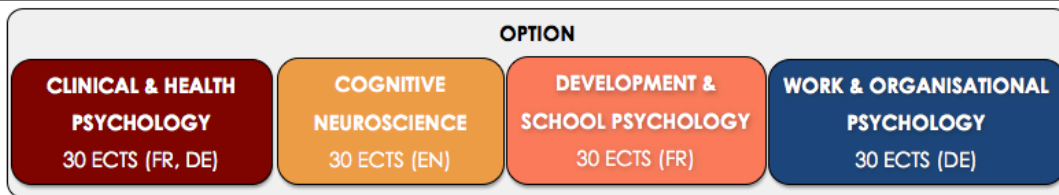

The four options

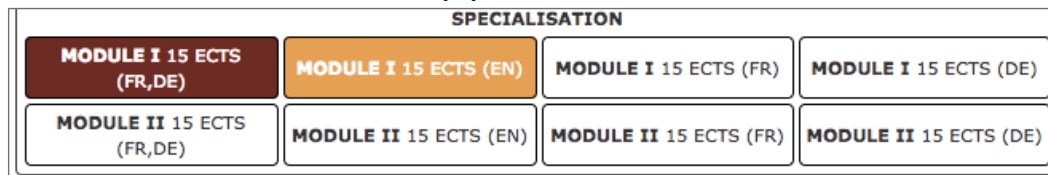


- You choose the option of your Master (main orientation)

## Specialisation module(s)

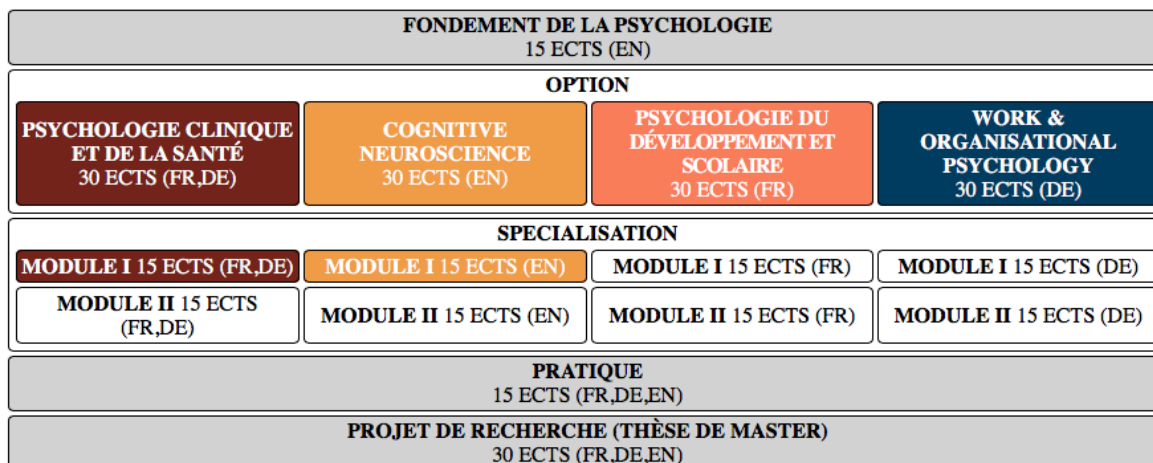


- Depending on the chosen option, 1 specialization module is included in your study plan.

### Master in Psychology, Clinical and Health Psychology

Each of the following modules is validated with 15 ECTS:

#### Psychopathology in Clinical and Health Psychology

Topical courses on evidence-based knowledge of etiology and treatment of mental disorders

**Specific topics and diagnostic skills in Clinical and Health Psychology**  
Specialized lectures in Clinical Child and Adolescent Psychology, Family Psychology, Behavioral Genetics and Psychosomatics. Training in diagnostics in Clinical and Health Psychology

#### Methods and Intervention

Application and implementation focused courses on the scientific backgrounds and basic strategies of preventive and psychotherapeutic interventions.

**Complementary knowledge from an optional module offered in Fribourg** including Development and School Psychology, Cognitive Neurosciences or Work & Organizational Psychology.

#### Master project and thesis

Students actively conduct and document their own research study, embedded in ongoing research projects and under supervision by members of the research groups

#### Clinical internship or Lab involvement

Students actively participate and gain experience in clinical practice or research under permanent guidance and supervision.

### Master in Psychology, Cognitive Neuroscience

#### Foundations in Psychology (15 ECTS)

General lectures covering elementary areas in psychology.

#### Current topics in Cognitive Neuroscience (15 ECTS)

Specialized lectures in cognitive, affective and social neuroscience, ethics, etc.

#### Methods and Data analysis (15 ECTS)

Hands-on experience in research methods and data analysis, including, EEG, fMRI, TMS, tDCS, Matlab, etc.

#### Lab rotation (15 ECTS)

Students set up and conduct experiments / analyze data in different research labs

**Master project and thesis (30 ECTS)**  
Research project elaborated, conducted and analyzed by master students with individual supervision.

#### Two options for specialization:

##### A: Clinical and developmental Neuroscience (30 ECTS)

Focus on cognitive development, clinical disorders and clinical neuroscience, school psychology, and cognition in infants as well as cognitive aging. Some courses in French only.

##### B: Social, cognitive and affective Neuroscience (30 ECTS)

Research seminars (e.g. social cognition, visual perception, emotion, memory, sleep, dreams) and scientific skills (reading, writing, presentation, discussion), inter-disciplinary courses are possible (e.g. clinical psychology, medicine, cognitive development, neurobiology, linguistics)

The program can be studied exclusively in English. Some courses in French / German. Begin in autumn or spring semester possible.

### Master in Psychology, Development & School

**Foundations in Psychology (15 ECTS)**  
General lectures covering elementary areas in psychology.

**Developmental Psychology (15 ECTS)**  
Modern theories of typical development. Atypical development (e.g., blind-, preterm-children, dyspraxia)

**School Psychology (15 ECTS)**  
Psychology of learning. Testing and deficiencies in fundamental skills (reading, writing, math). Case studies.

**Internship or Lab rotation (15 ECTS)**  
Students gain experience in practice or conduct experiments in research labs

**Master project and thesis (30 ECTS)**  
Research project elaborated, conducted and analyzed by master students with individual supervision. Supervision could be in French, German, or English

**Two options for specialization:**

**A: Clinical psychology (15 or 30 ECTS)**  
Psychopathology, Diagnosis, Intervention

**B: Neuroscience (15 or 30 ECTS)**  
Cognitive, affective and social neuroscience, Methods (EEG, fMRI, ERPs)


*The program is mostly in French. Some courses in English. Begin in autumn or spring semester possible.*

### Master in Psychology, Work and Organisational Psychology

Each of the following modules is comprises 15 ECTS:

**Foundations in Psychology**  
General lectures covering elementary areas in psychology.

**Work and Organisational Psychology**  
General lectures covering the important topics of work and organisational psychology (e.g. Stress at work).

**Occupational Health Psychology**  
Specialised lectures with a focus on how work influences employees' health, well-being and social relationships (e.g. personnel development, organisational justice, work & family).

**Human Factors**  
Specialised lectures with a focus on human-machine interaction (e.g. product usability, web accessibility).

**Complementary knowledge from an optional module offered in Fribourg** including Development and School Psychology, Clinical Psychology and Cognitive Neurosciences.

**Master project and thesis**  
Students conduct and document their own research study, embedded in ongoing research projects and supervised by members of the two research groups.

**Organisational Internship**  
Students gain experience during an internship in the field of work and organisational psychology under guidance and supervision of a psychologist.

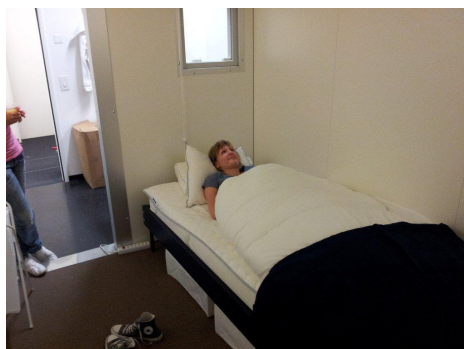
