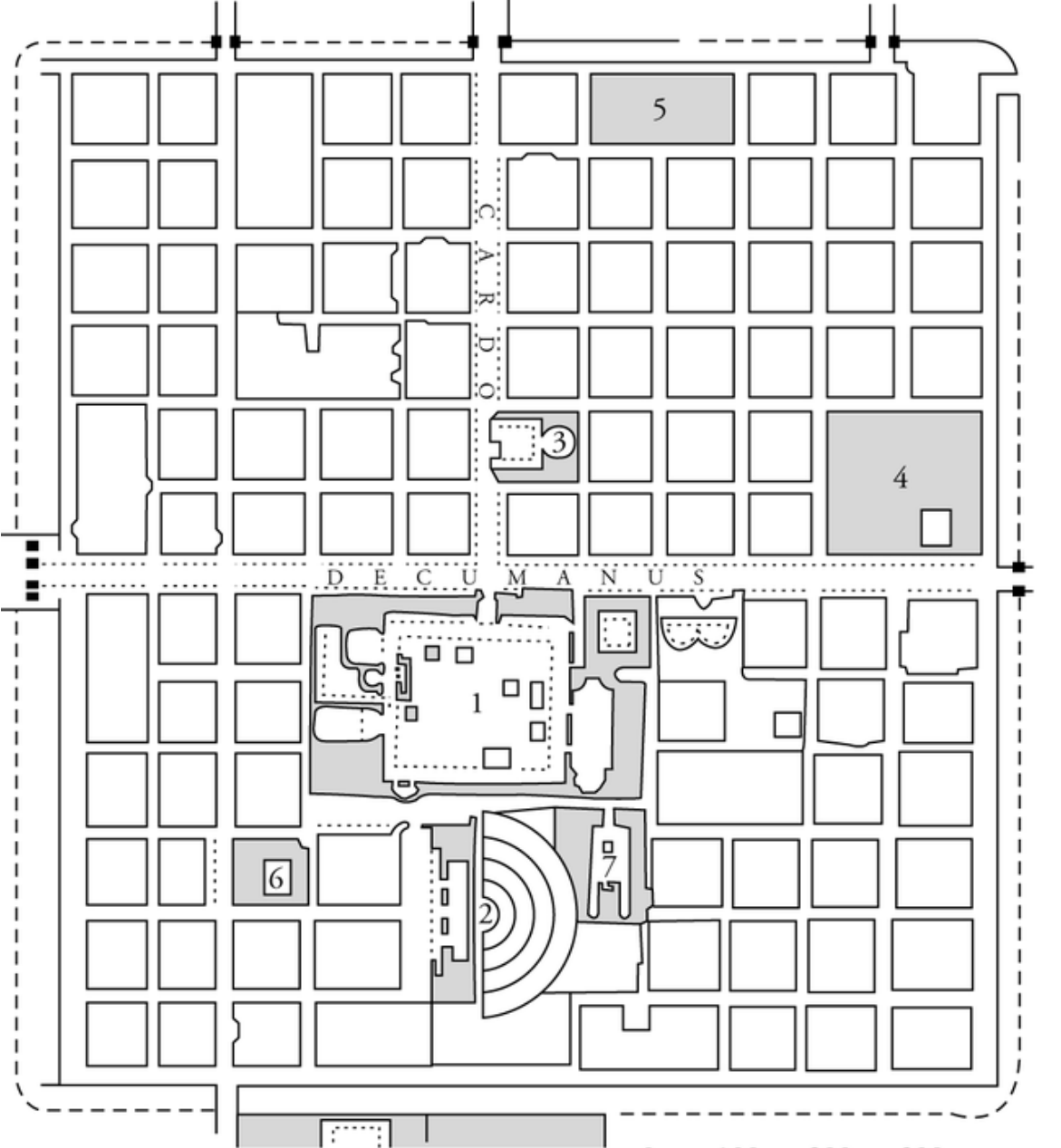

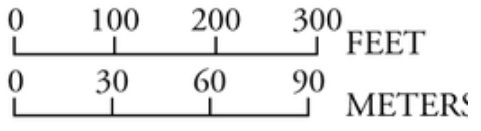

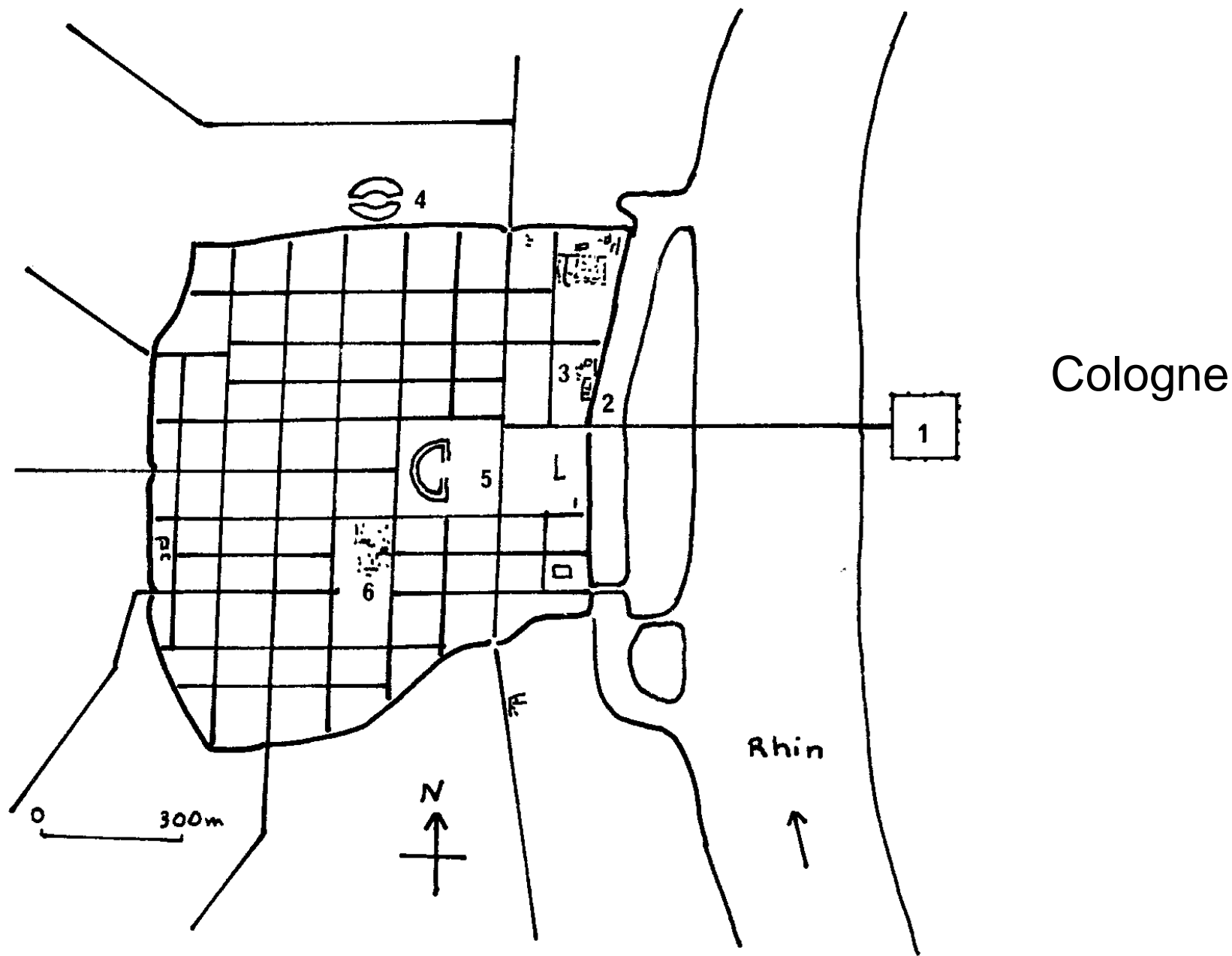


Timgad,

 primitive







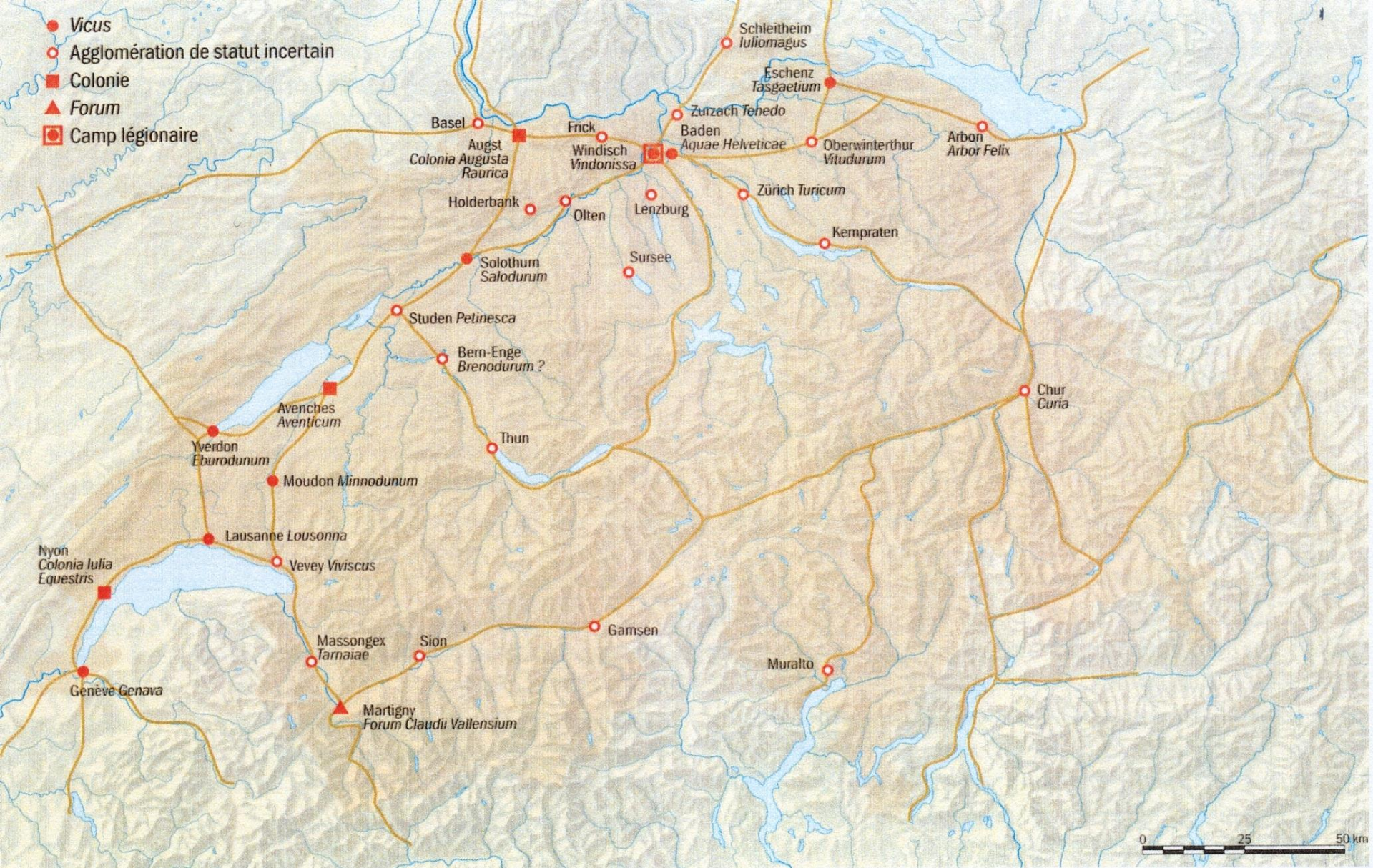

6. Forum triangulaire ; 7. *Cardo Maximus* ; 8. *Decumanus Maximus*.

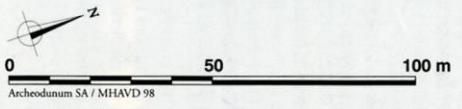

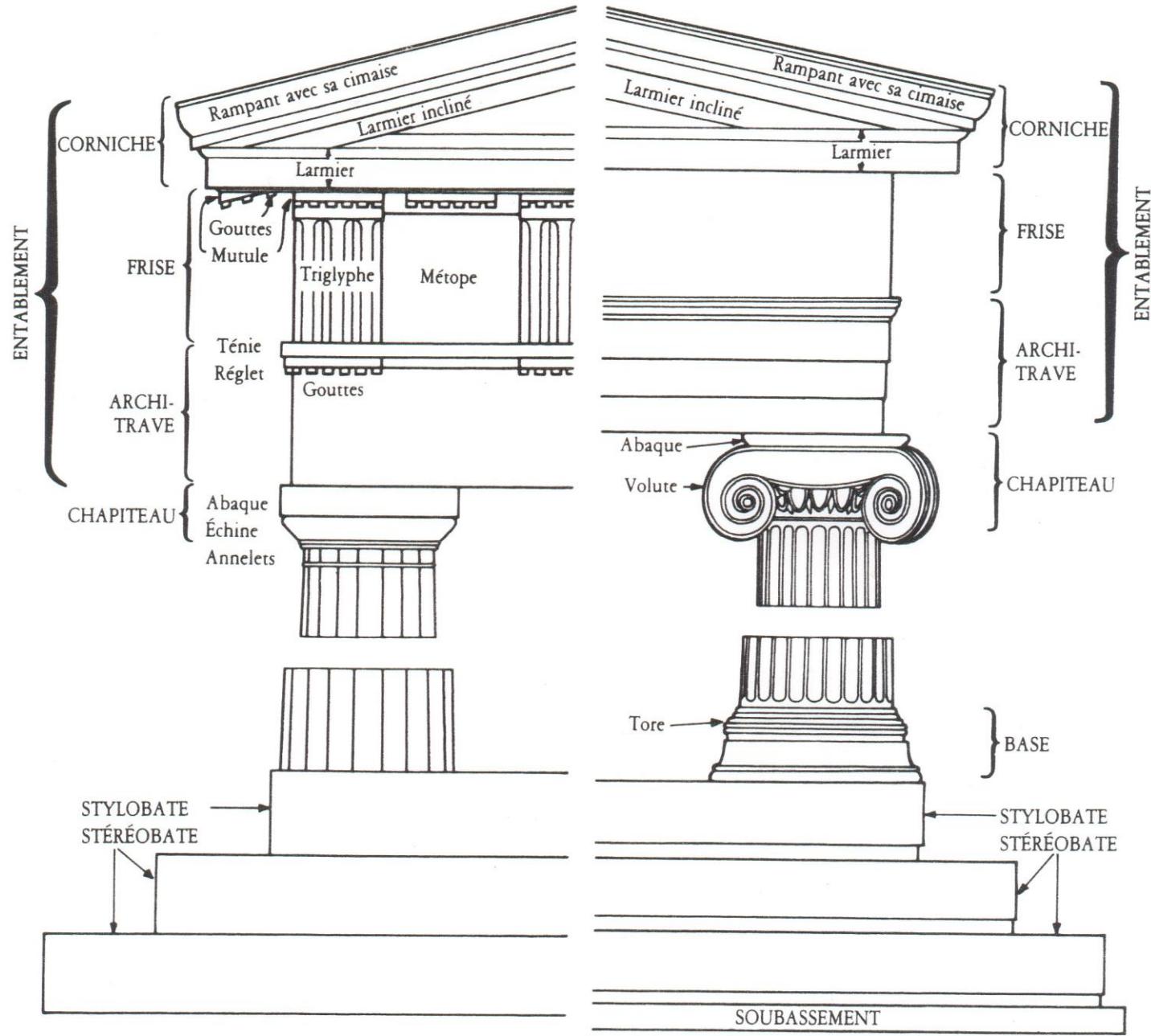

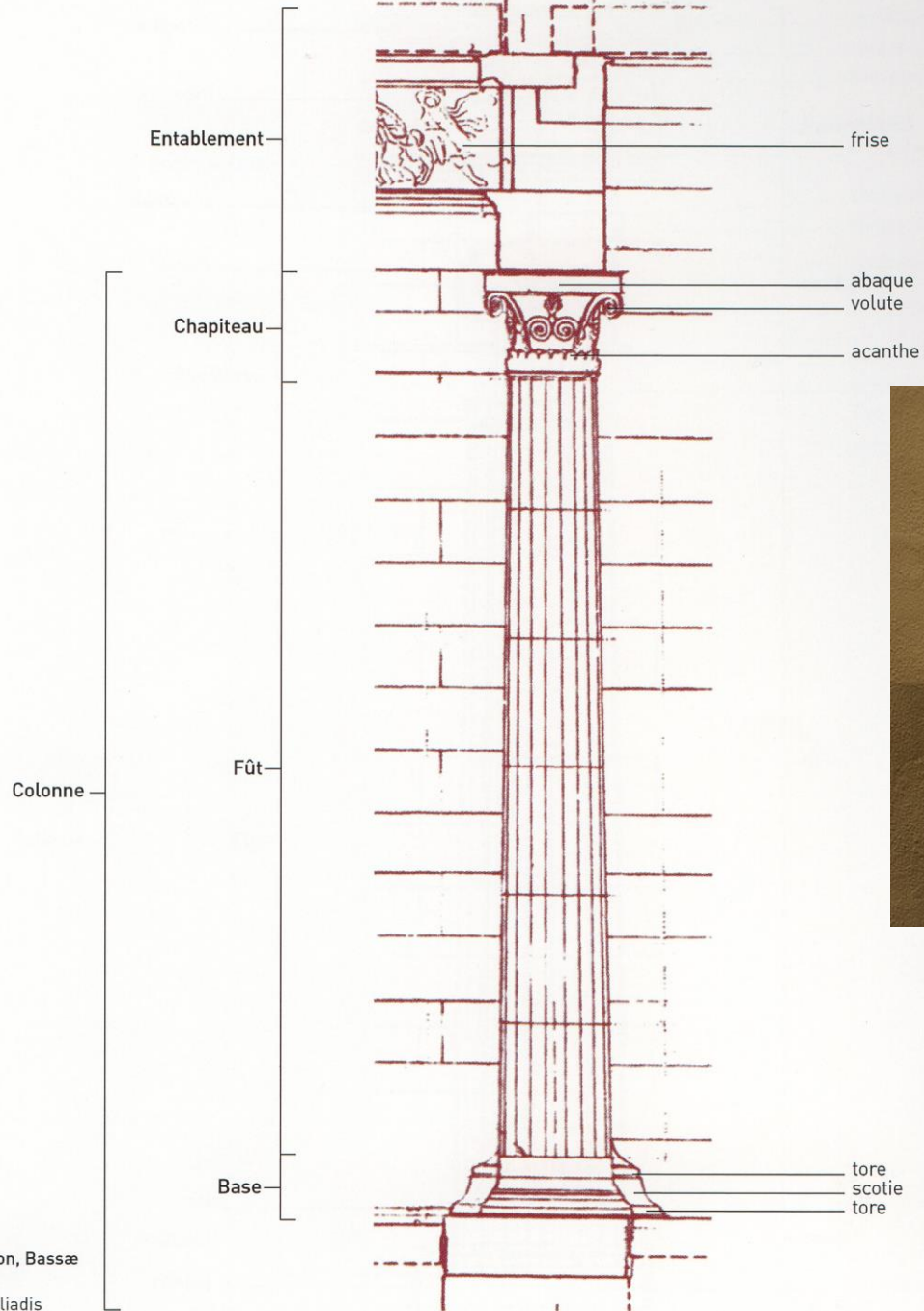

5. Maison des *triclinia* ; 6. Maison du *thermopolium*.

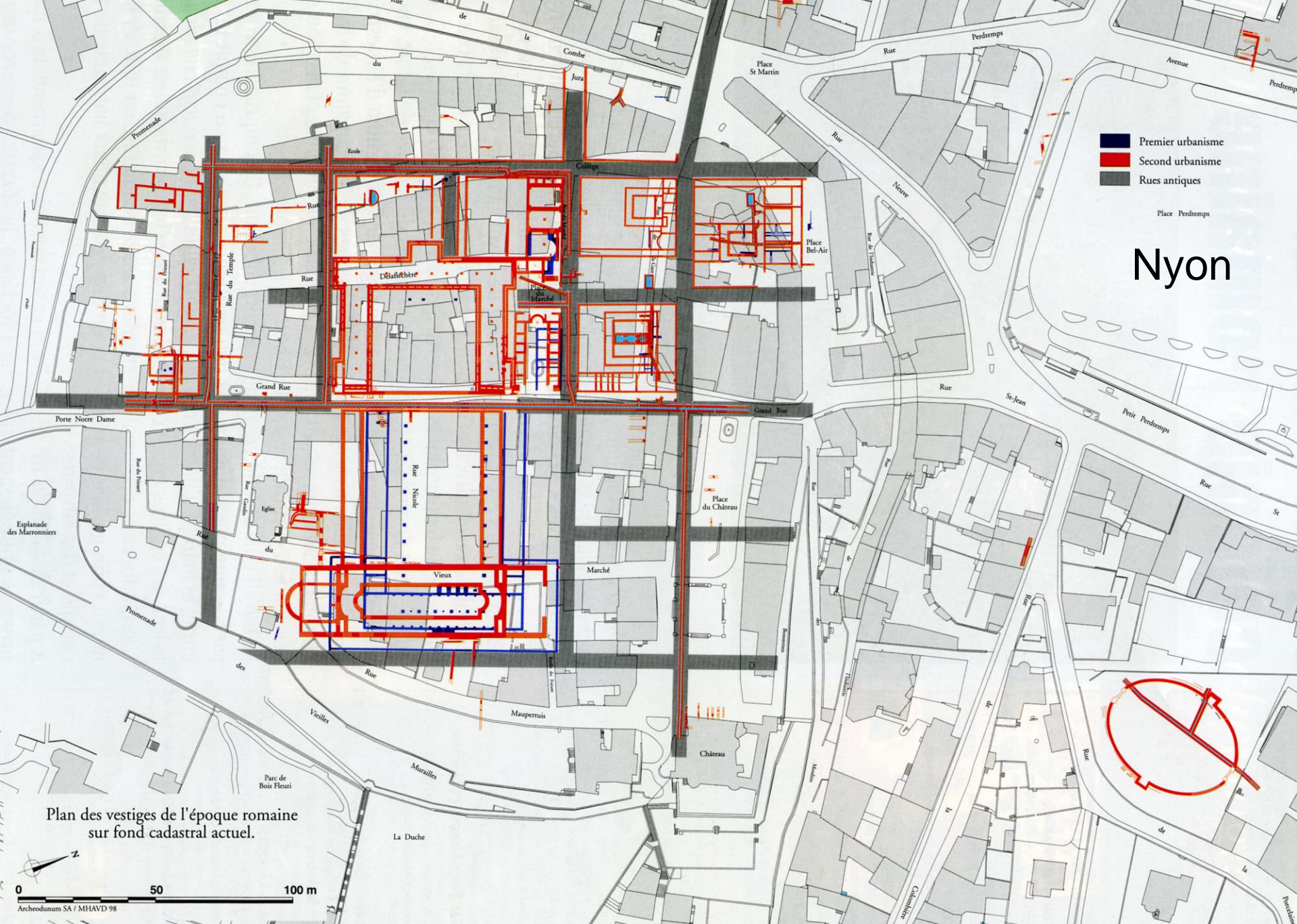

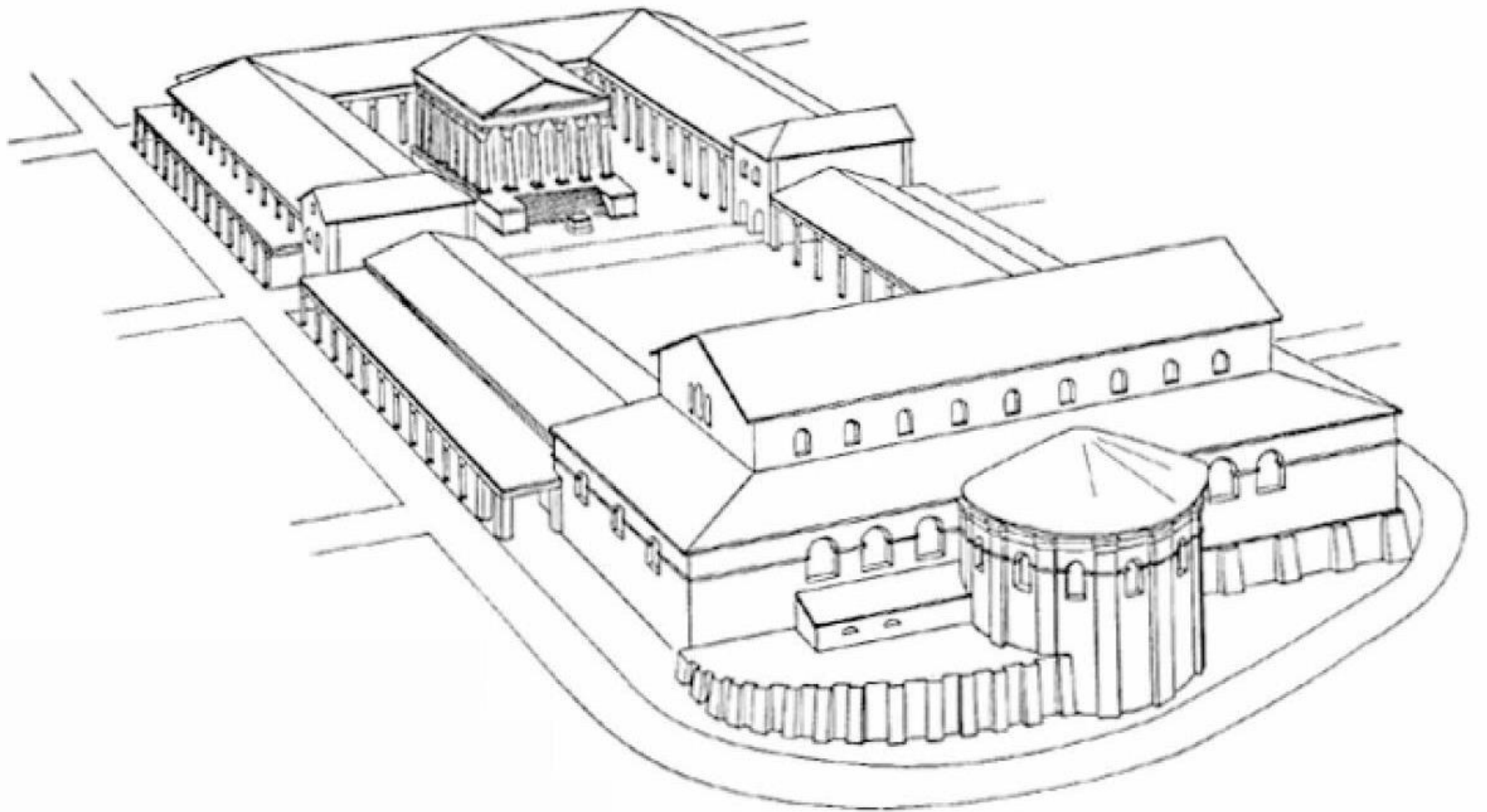




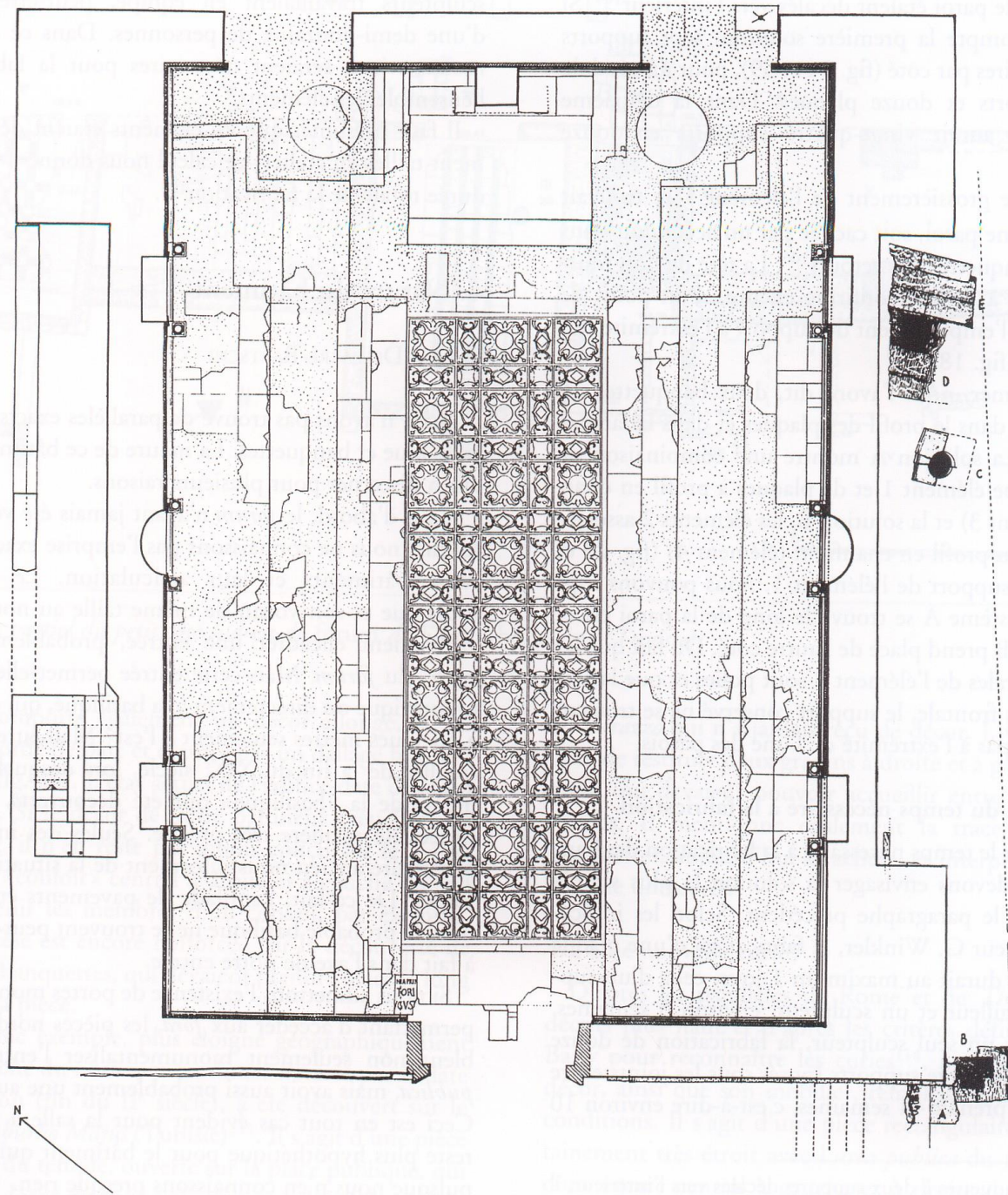
Plan du forum d'Augusta Raurica (Augst, Suisse)

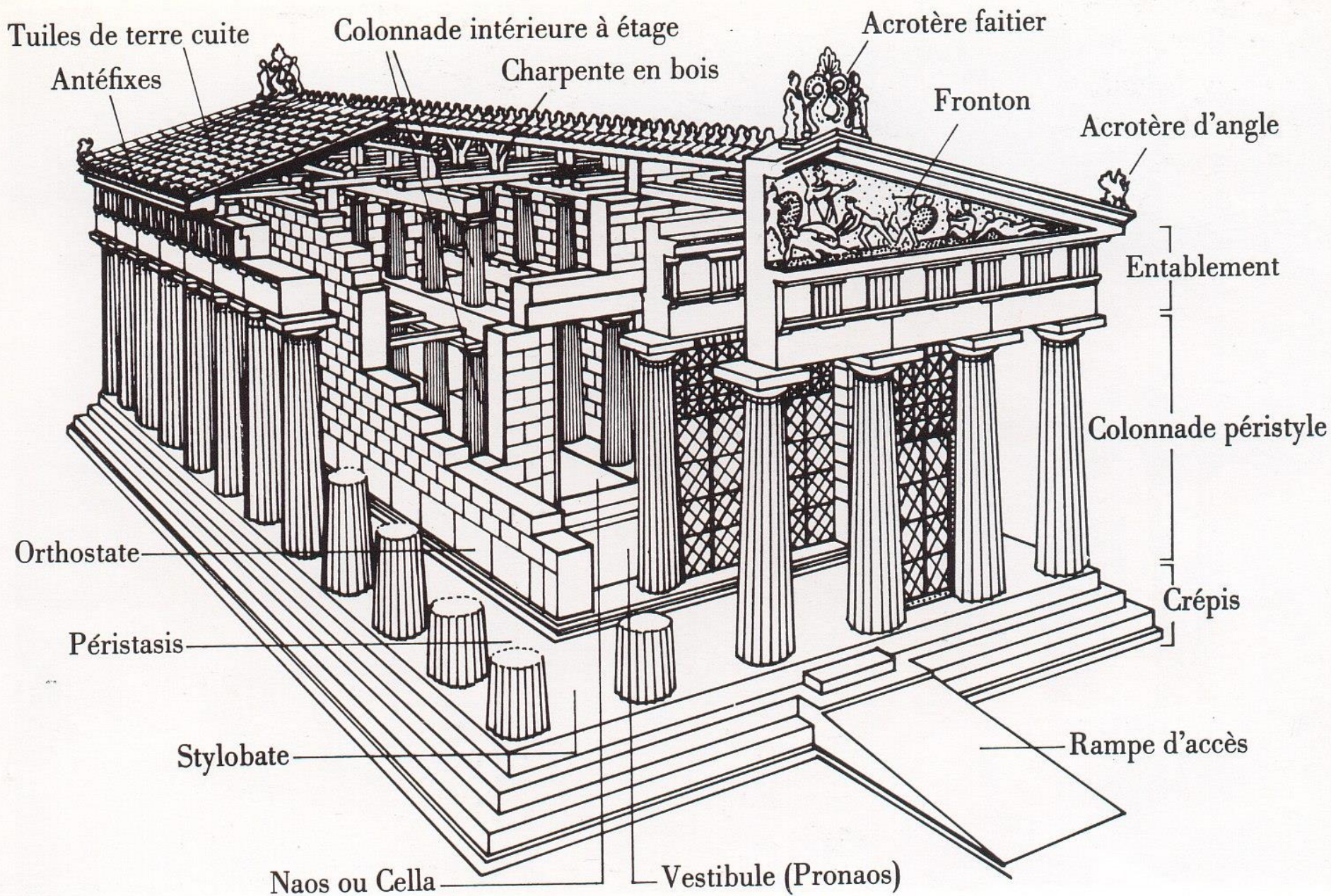

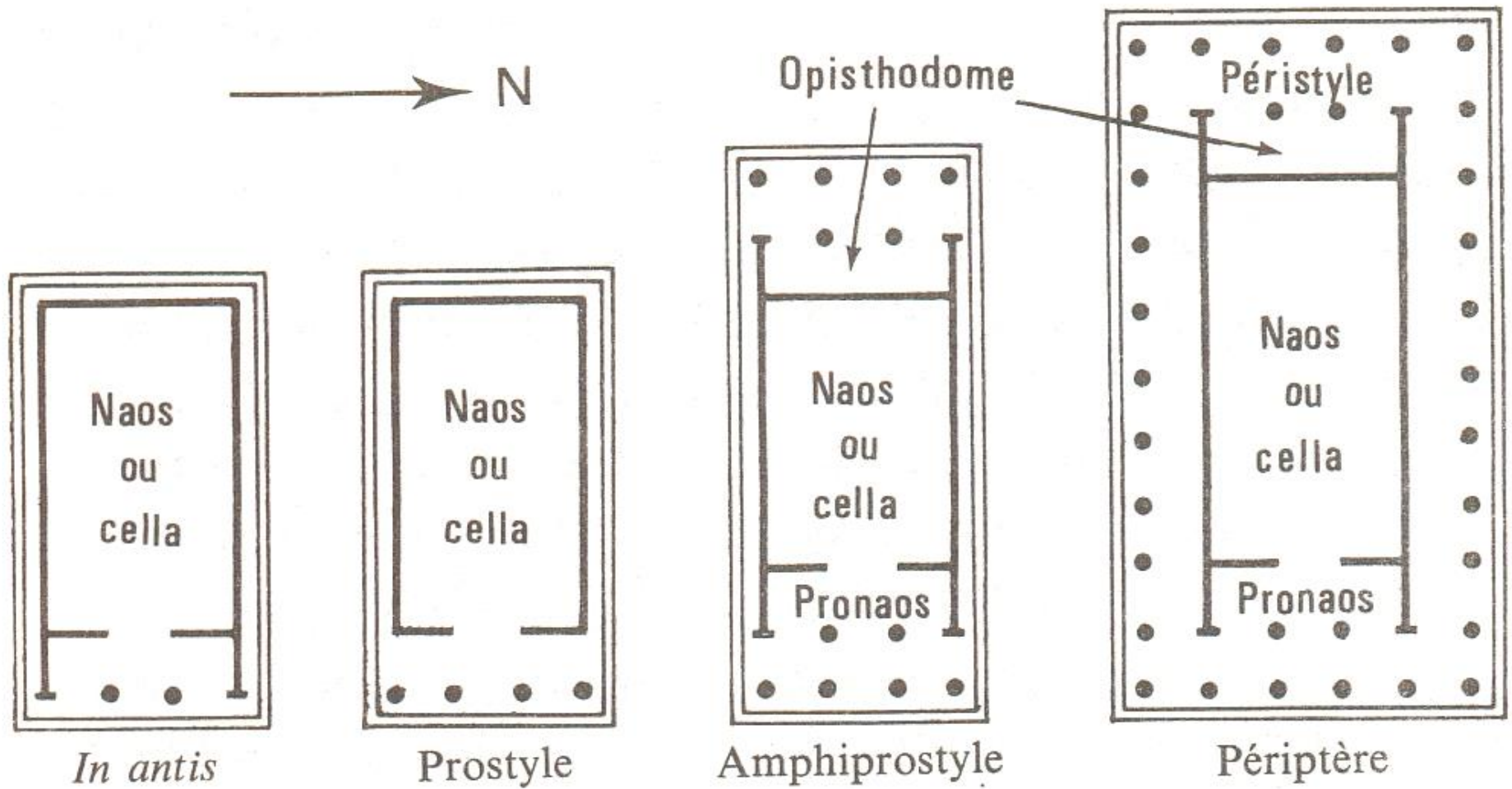

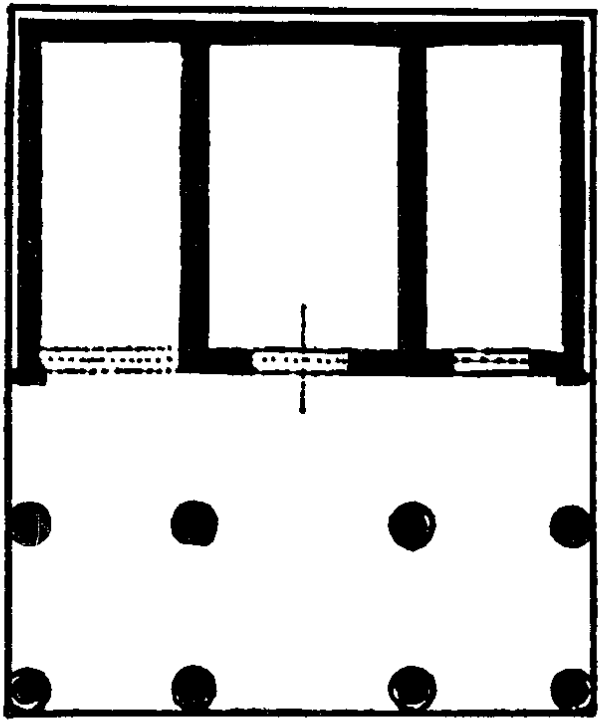

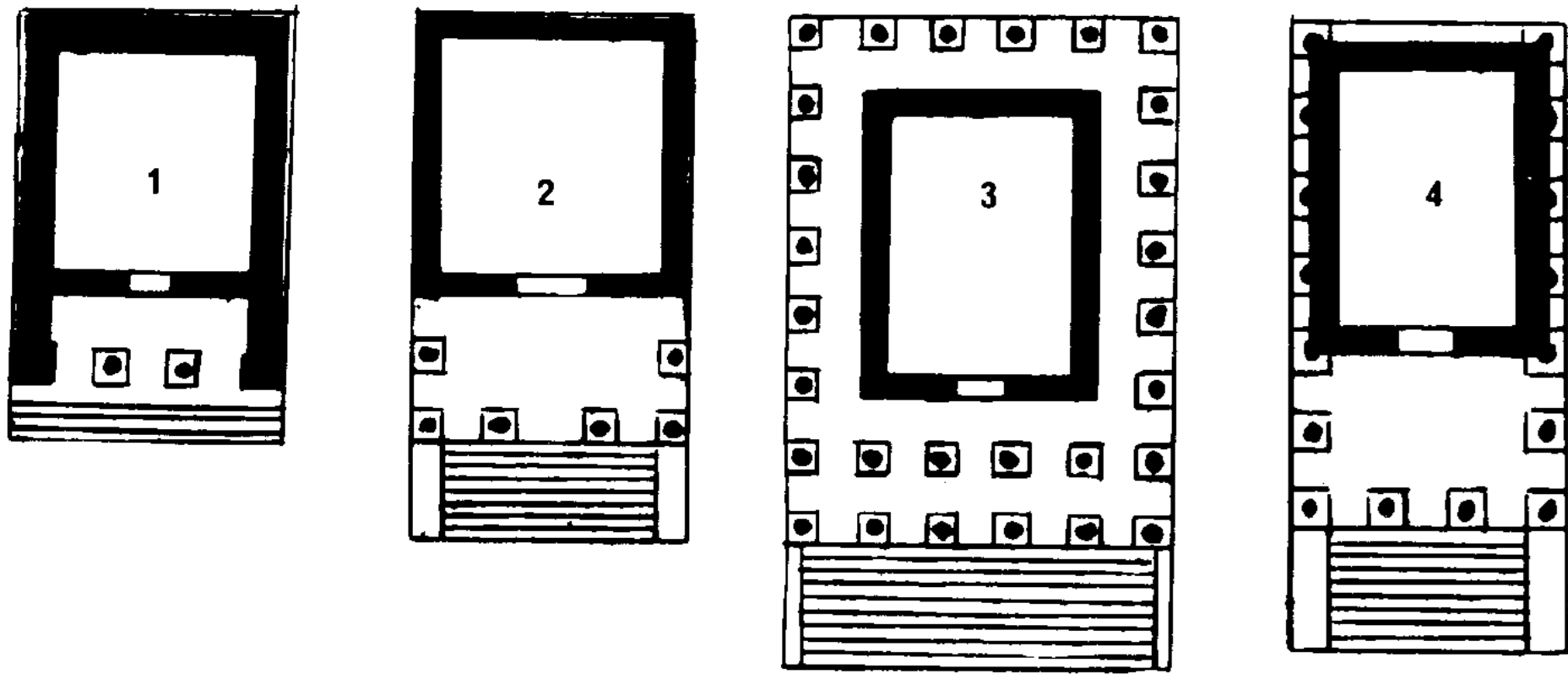
